



16-19 tuition fund statement

The Government has introduced the 16 to 19 tuition fund which is a £96 million of one-off funding for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Our share of this funding is £1336.

Eligible students are those who have not achieved a grade 5 or above in GCSE English or Maths. Students who haven't achieved a grade 4 in these subjects will be prioritised. This fund will be used to provide tuition support above and beyond our usual programme of study. We will use the allocated funding for small group (no more than 5 students) or individual tuition (prioritising English and Mathematics) depending on the needs of the identified students. The Fund is not limited to supporting GCSE Maths and English but can be for any aim in the learner's programme of study.
